Bachelor's – Master's Pathway Agreement

The Bachelor's – Master's Pathway allows 6 credit hours of graduate-level coursework to be double-counted toward an undergraduate degree (i.e., 6 credit hours of graduate coursework will be counted towards an undergraduate degree, and the same 6 hours of coursework will be counted towards a graduate degree). The department will provide a fellowship to cover the graduate portion of the tuition for those 6 credit hours, so that the student pays only the undergraduate portion of the tuition. The pathways program is intended to be limited to your home undergraduate institution. As such, the dual-counted credits may not be transferrable to another institution for graduate credit, including the other parent institution at the College of Engineering (e.g. FAMU may not accept transfer of graduate credits that were previously applied to an undergraduate degree at FSU, and vice versa).

In exchange for this benefit, I intend to seek a Master's degree in Civil Engineering from FAMU-FSU upon completion of my B.S. degree. (Students may enroll either full- or part-time in either the M.S. or M.Eng. degree programs, including online options, where available.)

In addition, I acknowledge the policy that:

- I need to receive a course grade of B or better to double-count the graduate course. If the course grade is lower than B, then the graduate course will count only toward the undergraduate degree.
- If my cumulative GPA drops below 3.0, I may be removed from the program and not permitted to take additional graduate coursework. In this case, pathways courses may not be counted toward the Master's degree.
- I need to carry a course load of no more than fifteen semester hours in any semester I take graduate courses.
